# **Ask Why**

Open with asking "why?" Invite the self-study team members to answer the following questions as prep work, then come together for discussion. This will provide the first step towards a shared understanding, building respect for one another, and establishing a productive working relationship. It will also indicate if more time is needed for research or clarification of answers. Keep the discussion general rather than personal, i.e. not about the pastor, administrator, or staff — but the ministries.
